

2009 Cabarrus 4-H Horse Eligibility Requirements
Cabarrus County, NC

1. Have a valid 4-H enrollment card on file in the Extension Office by the third Tuesday in January of the year requesting the card.
2. Youth must have participated in two 4-H sponsored activities between April 1, 2008 and March 31, 2009 to be eligible for a horse eligibility card for the current year. At least one of these events needs to be a non-horse related activity. This includes but is not limited to: 4-H Fashion Revue; 4-H Expressive Arts Celebration; 4-H Club Congress, any 4-H Camp; 4-H Hippology; 4-H Horse Bowl; 4-H Horse Judging; 4-H Artistic Expression Competition; Southwest District 4-H Teen Retreat; attend all County Council meetings; give a presentation at County Activity Day; participate in the 4-H Public Speaking competition; participate in a sufficient amount of community service (15+hours with form completed); participate/teach in 3 Summer Fling classes; participate in one Summer Fling day camp (such as Clover Camp, Fair Fun, or Mini-Society); create and display fair booth and volunteer at the Live 4-H Fair Booth one session; or turn in a Cumulative Record in February.
3. Must complete and turn in a project record in January.
4. Attend at least one County 4-H Horse meeting.
5. Meet the requirements of their individual clubs.
6. Be approved as having the skills necessary to compete in a show by their 4-H Club leader.
7. Follow eligibility rules outlined in the NC 4-H Horse Program Rules and Regulations Manual.
8. 4-H project horses cannot be trained by a professional within 60 days prior to competing in 4-H events and must be owned or leased by the 4-H member within the same time period.

To receive an eligibility card, please submit the attached form which outlines how you achieved these requirements. Include dates, description of activities, and any other valuable information. This outline must be turned in before agent will sign your Horse Eligibility card.

If you joined Cabarrus County 4-H between December 1-April 1 and wish to compete in the current year's show, you are expected to complete 1 item from #2.
